A morning bike ride followed by an afternoon Zoom discussion on stories of the Wolf Lake watershed will comprise this year's 20th annual Wolf Lake Bi-State Wetlands, Wind & Water festival on Saturday, May 29.

Sponsored by the Association for the Wolf Lake Initiative (AWLI), the bike ride begins at 8:30 a.m. at the rear parking to Calumet College of St. Joseph, 2400 New York Avenue. The ride ends at noon. Helmets and face masks will be required.

Participants will learn about aspects of the watershed and view spring wildflowers at seven or eight stops along the 20-mile trip.

The Zoom meeting begins at 3 p.m. with a discussion of stories from participants about their personal experiences in the watershed. Their stories will be recorded and will be made available on AWLI's website.

Previously, such discussions were recorded at AWLI meetings and now appear in a book on AWLI's 20-year history, *Over the Line*.
